THIS SUNDAY AT SPIRIT OF HOPE ALL SAINTS SUNDAY

While All Saints Day is November 1st of every year, the Church traditionally honors this day on the first Sunday in November of each year. 
BIBLE STUDY TONIGHT at 7:00 PM HEROES OF THE FAITH "INQUIRING HEROES"

THE APOSTLES' CREED: The First Article "I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth."

FROM THE LARGE CATECHISM

"...He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil..."

If none of these evils befalls us, we should consider this a gain and no small comfort in the evil that does in fact become our lot, and exclaim with Jeremiah, "It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed" (Lam. 3:22). When none of these things happens to us it is because the precenting right hand of the Most High surrounds us on all sides with great might and like a wall (as is seen in the case of Jon), so that Satan and the evils in their frustration can only be grievously vexed. From this we see how dearly we should love God whenever some evil afflicts us, for by that one evil our most loving Father would want us to see how many evils would threaten and attack us if he himself did not stand in the way. It is as if he said, 'Satan and a host of evils desire you that they may sift you as wheat (Luke 22:31), but I have been able to limit the sea and to say to it, 'To this place shall you come and here shall your proud waves be stayed,' as he says in Job 38:11." [AE 42:128-129]

FROM THE SCRIPTURES: "My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth... The Lord will keep you from all evil; He will keep your life" (Psalm 121:2;7).
