THIS SUNDAY AT SPIRIT OF HOPE - TRANSFIGURATION SUNDAY

This coming Sunday, February 11, we will continue our reading through the gospel of Luke at Spirit of Hope. Luke 6:12-26 covers Jesus calling His core 12 disciples and delivering the Sermon on the Plain. Making prayerful decisions and focusing on what is really important in life are topics for this week's message. Also this Sunday we will remember the Transfiguration of our Lord at the beginning of worship. We will read about the event in our Lord's life when He was transfigured before His disciples Peter, James and John, on a mountaintop. Moses and Elijah appeared with Jesus and the voice of God's approval came from heaven upon our Lord. Luke 9:28-36 provides the account of the story this year.

Fellowship starts at 9:00 am in the gym at Pine Lane Elementary North (6485 E Ponderosa Drive, Parker, CO 80138). Worship follows from 9:30 to 10:30 am. Sunday School begins as close to 10:45 am as possible.

POSSIBLE DEAD SEA SCROLLS ALL CHURCH EVENT

An exhibition is coming from March 16 through September 3 at the Denver Museum of Nature and Science on the Dead Sea Scrolls. Discovered in Israel in 1948, the scrolls (some of which are books of the Bible) date back over 2,000 years. We are thinking of possibly organizing a group from Spirit of Hope to go on a Sunday afternoon. A group of 10 or more people receives a 10% discount off the standard pricing. LENT BEGINS FEBRUARY 14

The season of Lent begins on Valentine's Day this year. In a coincidence of the calendar Ash Wednesday falls on February 14 in 2018. Spirit of Hope begins the Lenten season with the traditional solemn service of the imposition of ashes and Holy Communion. As in the past few years, the service will take place at the Ruth Memorial Chapel on Mainstreet (19650 Mainstreet, Parker, CO 80138) at 7:00 pm. Following Ash Wednesday, for the five Wednesdays of Lent we will once again have soup supper fellowship in the homes of our members followed by hymn singing and Bible Study. The list of

homes and dates will be published in upcoming newsletters. The theme for this Lenten season is "Tools from the Catechism." Each Wednesday we will look at one of the five sections of Martin Luther's Small Catechism along with selected Bible passages to see what insights are provided for Christian living today. Plan now to spend some time in fellowship, worship and study this Lenten season.

BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

After a meeting with our general contractor, Skarco, a newly revised completion date estimate of May 1 has been given. This is dependent upon receiving the fire department's final approval for the fire suppression system. Once obtained, key components of the system (most notably the fire pump) can be ordered and the installation of the interior piping for the system can begin. In the meantime, other work on the site continues as scheduled. Once all the interior rough work is completed (fire sprinkler piping, HVAC, plumbing, electrical) and passes inspection the rest of the project should move rather quickly. Dry wall, landscaping, sidewalks, pump house construction, interior paint, interior fixtures, cabinetry and flooring will all be installed after passing rough interior inspection. Thank you once more for your prayers for the safe completion of the building project.
