
TOMORROW'S LENTEN WEDNESDAY EVENT

A CALL TO ORDAINED PASTORAL MINISTRY By Pastor Dave

As announced on Sunday, February 21st, one of our members at Spirit of Hope, Wendy Poch, has discerned a call from the Lord to pursue pastoral ministry in our association, Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ (LCMC). Wendy has been praying and thinking about seeking ordained pastoral ministry for several months now and has been in conversation with me, her family and other brothers and sisters both in and outside of the congregation. At last month's Church Board meeting she was unanimously endorsed and encouraged by all the board members to pursue this new venture. Wendy has applied to one of the institutions that LCMC is partnered with for the training and equipping of new pastors, Beyond the River Academy (BTRA). BTRA is a cutting edge institution for the training of pastoral candidates for LCMC. Making extensive use of current technology, students at BTRA are able to live in their current homes and basically "field train" for pastoral ministry. The good news in this is that Wendy and her family will not have to move to a distant city to train in a seminary, but will get to stay in Parker and at Spirit of Hope while she studies to be a pastor. Wendy has sent her application in and, if all proceeds as expected, she will begin her studies in July. The process normally takes anywhere from two to five years depending on how fast a student is able to complete course work. Please pray and encourage Wendy as she begins this adventure and seeks the Lord's will for this part of her life.

BUILDING PROJECT NEWS

Over the next two weeks the fire suppression tanks are due to be delivered and installed. Before that delivery, approximately 25 tons of pea gravel will be placed as a bedding material in the hole that has been dug for the tanks. Once the tanks are in our general contractor will arrange for the piping from the tanks and a fire hydrant to be installed. In the meantime we are working to get recycled asphalt scheduled to be delivered so that it can be spread and compressed in the parking lot. This will be one of the "self-perform" work items and we will need some volunteers to help with the spreading and compacting when that happens. All of these items are required by the

fire department before we can start using combustible materials like wood when we put up the walls.

THE THORN - EASTER PAGENT AT SOUTHEAST CHRISTIAN

Some of our members at Spirit of Hope have seen the production entitled, The Thorn. This year one of our members, Tiffany Poch, is a cast member. The Thorn is a presentation of the passion of Jesus in a unique way. Sometimes referred to as "tame Easter play meets Cirque du Soleil and Jackie Chan," the Gospel is clearly presented in both the production itself and in a pastoral presentation near the end of each performance. The production utilizes a national touring cast and crew supplementing that cast and crew with local volunteers. This year the Parker English language showing of The Thorn will take place on Friday, March 11, at 7:30 pm and Saturday, March 12, at 10:00 am and 7:30 pm at Southeast Christian Church.
