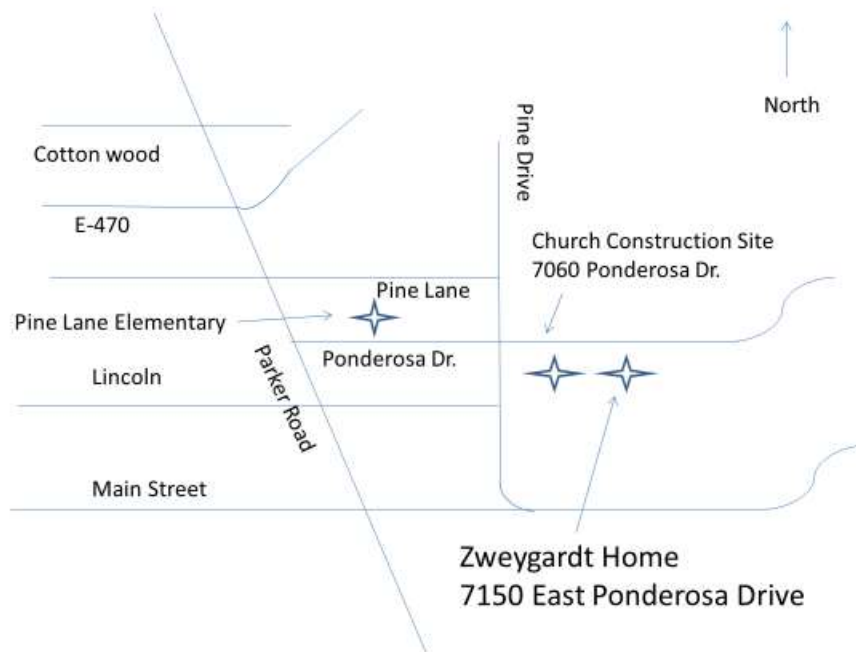

## **HOLY WEEK SERVICES AT SPIRIT OF HOPE!**

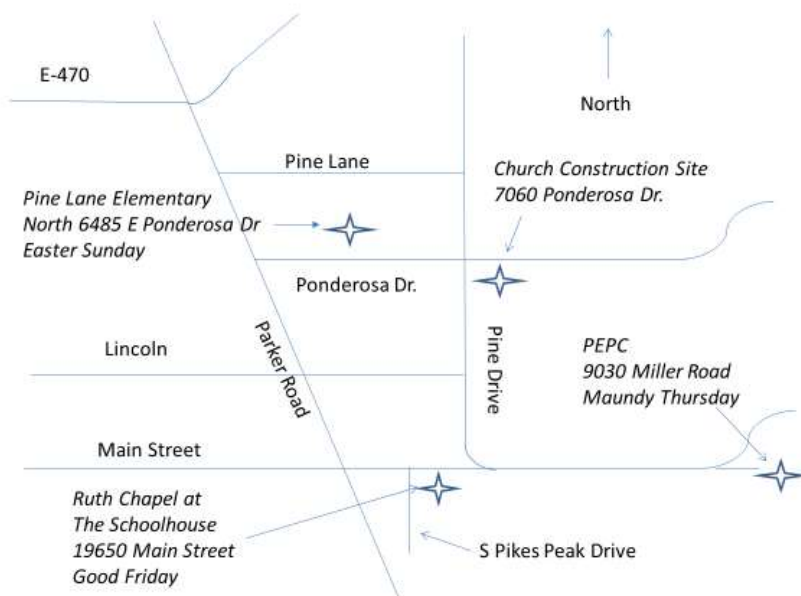
Holy Week begins this year on Sunday, March 25. At Spirit of Hope we will have our Palm and Passion Sunday celebration at our current meeting facility of Pine Lane Elementary North. We will remember Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem on the first Palm Sunday. All worshippers will be given a palm frond for this part of the service. The passion account from the gospel of Luke will be read as an overview to the events we will remember during Holy Week that culminate on Easter Sunday.

Maundy Thursday worship will be held at 7:00 pm on March 29 at Parker Evangelical Presbyterian Church (9030 Miller Road, Parker, CO 80138). The account of Jesus' Last Supper and the celebration of Holy Communion will highlight this service.

On March 30, at 7:00 pm, Good Friday Worship will take place at the Ruth Memorial Chapel at the Schoolhouse facility (19650 Mainstreet, Parker, CO 80138). We return to a more traditional, Lutheran service of shadows (also known as "Tenebrae"). We will read the account of Jesus' crucifixion from the gospels as well as sing traditional Good Friday and Holy Week hymns.

We return to Pine Lane Elementary North for the celebration of The Resurrection of our Lord, Easter Sunday, April 1. Festival worship will be led by our Spirit of Hope Choir and feature Easter hymns and communion as we celebrate Jesus' victory over death!

Plan now to attend all these worship opportunities and draw nearer to God!

## **MARION MEDICAL MISSION TRIP OPPORTUNITY**

If you would like to participate in a life changing mission trip to Africa that will save lives and dramatically improve quality of life in hundreds of villages by providing safe drinking water, applications are now available online at [www.mmmwater.org](http://www.mmmwater.org). Volunteers deliver pumps and pipe, help with installation, document information for each well and participate in a dedication ceremony at each village. Trip length is 25 days with dates this year 14 September through 8 October for team one, and 5 October through 29 October for team two.

Applications must be submitted before April 1 and team selections will be announced by April 15th. Volunteers are responsible for their own transportation, insurance, visas, food, lodging and required immunizations. Total cost is about \$3,000, but don't let that be the reason you don't apply. Mission funds and sponsorship are available to make the cost manageable.

If you feel led to this opportunity Wayne Schultz is available to answer any questions you might have and to help with the application process and preparation for the trip.
