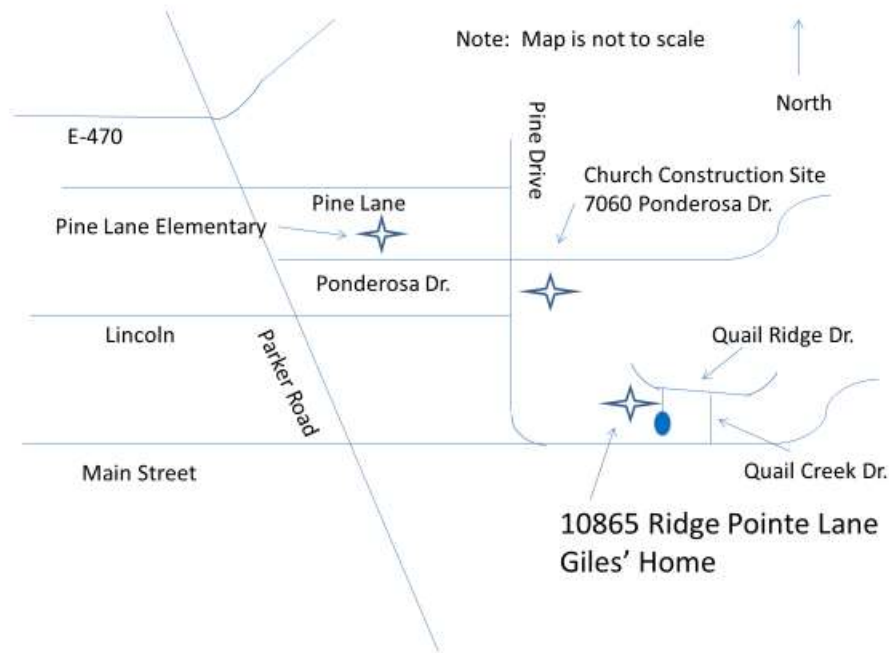

THIS SUNDAY AT SPIRIT OF HOPE – 4th SUNDAY IN LENT

Acts 23:12-35 forms the basis of Sunday's message. The apostle Paul discovers a plot on his life and informs the Roman commander holding him about it. CONGREGATIONAL MEETING RESULT (Updated)

On Sunday, March 12, a special congregational meeting was held at Spirit of Hope Lutheran Church's current worship meeting place of Pine Lane Elementary South. The purpose of this meeting was to present information related to proceeding with the current building project to a certificate of occupancy that is within the financial capability of the congregation and to vote on a recommendation to that effect.

At the conclusion of the meeting the following resolution was moved and passed unanimously:

Whereas, Final construction plans have been approved and permitting issues resolved, and

Whereas, Funding required has been identified, be it

Resolved, That on this the 12th day of March 2017, the congregation of Spirit of Hope Lutheran Church, authorizes the Church Board to enter into a revised contract with Skarco Design for completion and certificate of occupancy for the designed facility, including a finished fellowship hall if funds are available. The cost for completion of the project is not to exceed available funds and is limited to a maximum debt of \$1,500,000.

The revised contract was reviewed last week with the contractor and is expected to be signed this coming week. Revised member loan notes will be presented for signature to members over the next two to three weeks. In the meantime, our general contractor, Skarco Design, is finishing obtaining some minor county and fire department permits and will mobilize for construction. Construction is now scheduled to resume by April 7. Thank you again for your continued support and prayers for the building project.
