BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

Praise be to God! Last Thursday the fire department approved the interior building sprinkler design for the fire suppression system! This allows the project to proceed in the interior of the church

building. The rough plumbing and sprinkling for that system is commencing this week. Also, the installation of audio-visual and security wiring will happen as well. Once those two items are completed the building will be ready for a major milestone inspection of all the roughed in electrical, mechanical and plumbing systems. Once that inspection is successful the insulation, drywall, flooring, painting and fixture work can proceed.

Meanwhile exterior work has been done in the last few weeks. Trees were planted and irrigation systems have been installed. The sidewalks and main entrance patio were poured last week. The construction of the exterior pump house should begin shortly. If there are no more delays, our general contractor Skarco has indicated the project could be completed by mid-summer.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THOSE OVER 70 ½ WHO RECEIVE REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS (RMDs) FROM IRAs

Did you know if you are receiving RMDs (or plan to receive them for the first time in 2018) that you have an opportunity to save Federal income taxes while continuing your support of the ministry of Spirit of Hope? Here's how.....

A little-known provision of the IRS tax code permits RMD recipients to make Qualified Charitable Contributions, or QCDs, up to a total of \$100,000 per year (on a weekly, monthly or annual basis), directly from IRAs to charities without having to include those contributions in income while, at the same time, fulfilling RMD requirements.

The ability to give directly to a charity and to avoid reporting the amount given as income is a huge advantage to taxpayers. Additionally, lowering income can help reduce the taxable amount of Social Security benefits and reduce the amount of the Medicare surtax for taxpayers with high incomes.

Using QCD's for charitable giving is beneficial not only for those who itemize deductions but could be particularly beneficial to those who do not itemize. Recently passed tax legislation increased the 2018 standard deduction for singles and married couples to \$12,000 and \$24,000, respectively. These increased limits mean many charitable deductions could be lost in 2018 and beyond. However, the tax benefit of the gift can still be realized by making a QCD thus removing the gift amount from taxable income.

It is very important to note that QCDs cannot be payable first to you with the intent that you turnaround and write a contribution check. In order to qualify as a QCD, all such contributions must be made directly from the IRA custodian to Spirit of Hope. At the end of each calendar year, our Financial Secretary will acknowledge receipt of all QCDs to donors for tax reporting purposes.

If this approach is of interest to you, please discuss it with your tax preparer and contact your IRA custodian in order to determine the custodian's QCD procedure for making regular contributions to Spirit of Hope throughout the year.
