QUICK SPIRIT OF HOPE FINANCIAL UPDATE

May income = \$37,235

General Fund Offerings = \$15,480

Debt Reduction Offerings = \$1,400

Dedicated Offerings = \$20,350*

Other Income = \$5**

May expenses (to date) = \$22,645***

Checking = \$29,603

Money Market = \$23,219 (Reserves = \$10,436 Dedicated = \$12,783)
