## **BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE**

**As many of you are aware from my announcements on Sunday, we had a major water event inside the church building over the weekend. A pipe in our water purification system leaked and the storage room and fellowship area were flooded with about an inch of water. Thank you to Tom Clausen, Ramie Larson and Rodney Pobar for helping me to vacuum and push out the water until a service person was able to arrive to finish the clean-up. Things are drying out and a possible insurance claim has been initiated. The general contractor and subcontractors are working not only on repairs but preventative solutions so that this will not happen again. Meanwhile, we are still in the inspection process with the fire suppression system. A special part had to be order and electrical wiring had to be done before the next fire department inspection of a performance test of the fire pump can happen. That work is scheduled for this week. Please continue to pray for God's help as we pursue completion of this project.**
