BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

As many of you have seen and heard the framing for the building started last week! There is a construction fence up and the water tanks have been mostly buried and the in-line piping for the fire suppression system has been completely covered. There is shiny new yellow fire hydrant at the south west corner of the structure. Framing, truss installation, particle boards on the walls and roof boards are estimated to take six weeks total (so there are about five weeks to go).

Meanwhile permanent electrical power is scheduled for installation in the next few weeks. Thank for your prayers once again. It is good to see some vertical progress finally happening. Please keep up those prayers!
