Spirit of Hope is in the beginning stages of exploring the possibility of becoming a Stephen Ministry Congregation. Stephen Ministers are congregation members that go through formal training that equips them to serve church and community members in need, such as those experiencing various forms of grief, trauma, stress, or who would benefit from someone walking alongside them during physically, emotionally and spiritually difficult times. An attachment
